**HOW DOES THE EXECUTIVE AND NEGOTIATING TEAM COLLECT FEEDBACK FROM MEMBERS BEFORE PROCEEDING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING?**

**Collecting feedback from members occurs in several stages:**

- **Email solicitations:** in April and May 2015 FAUST solicited bargaining feedback from members via the FAUST listserv. Several Full-Time and Part-Time members responded. Their responses were forwarded to the Negotiating Team.
- **Bargaining survey:** on 29 January 2016, Trevor Sawler presented the results of the Part-Time and Full-Time

bargaining surveys to the membership, which were discussed at the meeting.

- **\*\*\*Consultations with Executive members\*\*\***: between now and the presentation of bargaining priorities on **26 February 2016**, the Executive invites Full-Time and Part-Time members to freely consult with Executive members about their bargaining priorities.
